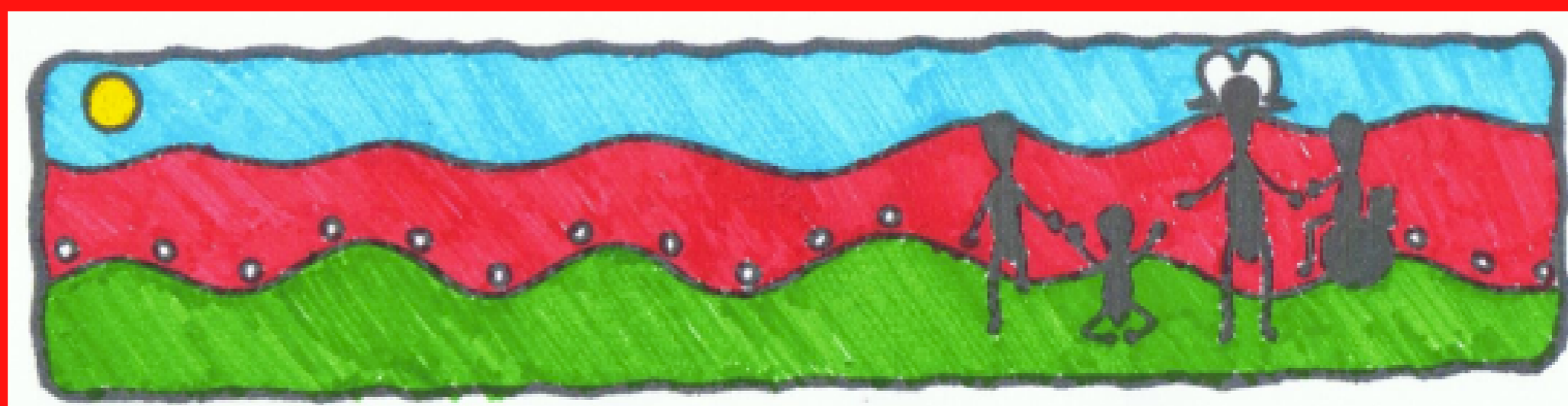
The morning will include:
